Established in 1994, NTIHC is a pioneer adolescent health program in Uganda positioned to provide Adolescent Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (ASRHR) services, youth activities and information, primarily targeting young people of 10 -24 years old. NTIHC, with an office and youth clinic at Kiswa Health Centre, supports 7 KCCA health facilities in Kampala and other 24 Public health facilities 8 districts neighboring Kampala to provide quality ASRH services.

## Reporting Relationship

The **Medical Service Provider - Nurse/Counsellor** will report to the Service Delivery Manager.

## Job Summary

The Nurse/Counselor will attend to the Reproductive Health needs of young people. She/he will assess clients' health problems and needs, develop and implement nursing care plans, and maintain medical records.

## Core Duties and Responsibilities

1. Ensure that all treatment and management of clients is offered according to national policies, procedures and guidelines
2. Provide quality sexual and reproductive health related services to young people including pregnancy related services, infertility, provision of contraceptives, STI management and other medical issues related to growing up, nutrition and hygiene.
3. Monitor, record and report symptoms and changes in patients' conditions, their medical information and vital signs and modify patient treatment plans as indicated by patients' responses and conditions.
4. Provide psychosocial counseling and advice to young people relating to their reproductive health
5. Provide quality sexual and reproductive health related services to young people in the community through outreach services
6. Liaising with partner agencies, other health and social care professionals to ensure service continuity and support through referral.

7. Liaise with other stakeholders such as parents, schools and community leaders to increase access
8. Order, interpret, and evaluate diagnostic tests to identify and assess patient's condition.
9. Record and document all data and information related to services provided to young people
10. Participate in capacity building and supervision of other service providers in the provision of adolescent sexual and reproductive health services
11. Actively participate in behavior change and communication activities including counseling, health discussions with young people, toll free counseling and community mobilization.
12. And any other lawful responsibilities as may be assigned from time to time by your supervisor and or any other superiors.

## Knowledge, skills, and abilities required

1. A degree or diploma in Nursing or related field.
2. A diploma or certificate in counselling and guidance will be an added advantage.
3. Very good verbal and communication skills.
4. Basic computer skills.
